

Emergency Ride Home^(ERH) Self-Serve Program

A workplace commuting program offered by Longwood Collective

Not driving alone to Longwood?

Transit riders, bikers, walkers & carpool passengers receive **3 free (Lyft) rides from Longwood to home**, (per/year) for illness or emergency for yourself or someone in your care



Signing up for ERH Self-Serve and booking a ride is as easy as:

- 1 [Register in the GoLongwood online platform and join the "Longwood ERH" network](#)
- 2 Complete the ERH Agreement Form and email to TMA@Longwoodcollective.org
- 3 Once employer is confirmed, you'll be invited to create/link your Lyft account
- 4 When an emergency/illness arises, book your ride from the LMA to home via the Lyft app
- 5 Submit a [confirmation report](#) within a week of program use (TMA@longwoodcollective.org)

ERH travel DOES NOT cover:

- ✓ Travel from locations outside of the LMA into the District
- ✓ Something that is NOT an illness or emergency for yourself/ someone in your care
- ✓ Transit/ travel disruptions due to weather or running late on your shift
- ✓ Scheduled medical appointments or medical situations related to pre-existing conditions

Program abuse will result in billing the user for the cost and possible program expulsion

Emergency Ride Home^(ERH) Self-Serve Agreement Form

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In addition to the standard ERH program, Longwood Collective offers employees the chance to schedule your own ERH for illness/ emergency for yourself/ someone in your care. Complete and return this form by email (tma@longwoodcollective.org) to participate. Once your employer has been verified you will be invited to create/ toggle a Lyft account to Longwood Collective's. Participants are eligible for **3 free (Lyft) rides from Longwood to home** per calendar year.

By signing up for "ERH Self-Serve" I am aware and agree to the following requirements:

- I registered in [GoLongwood](#) using a workplace email and joined the "[LongwoodERH](#)" network
- Program use is specifically for:
 - emergency/illness for myself or someone in my care
 - travel from Longwood to home or the location of emergency
- I will not use ERH for:
 - traveling from points outside of the LMA into the district
 - transit/ travel disruptions due to weather or running late on my shift
 - something that is a scheduled doctors appointment or a pre-existing condition
 - something that is not an emergency/ illness
- I will submit a [confirmation report](#) within a week of program use
